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On **December 8, 2017**, Medical Data Vision (MDV) announced a business alliance with TechMatrix Corporation and the launch of a new service.

In November, the company signed a business alliance agreement with TechMatrix Corporation, and as a result will begin providing a new service from December 8, 2017.

Objective of business alliance

TechMatrix Corporation provides cloud services with high added value to the fields of medical, CRM, and internet services. It also provides network security solutions by combining advanced technology and products from overseas with its own technology. In this business alliance, Medical Data Vision and TechMatrix aim to construct an environment in which patients can manage all of their medical information themselves over the span of their lives, and to this end, they intend to develop and provide services that combine the technology and know-how of their two companies.

As their first project, from December 8, 2017, they will begin a service in which users can view DICOM (Digital Imaging and COmmunications in Medicine) standard medical images on the company's Karutecho service. This service was made possible by incorporating TechMatrix's NOBORI cloud service, which stores, uses, and shares medical information, such as images, safely. The DICOM standard is the international standard for storing and transmitting digital image data, such as various examination and medical data, including CT and MRI scans. Currently, in most situations a patient seeking a second opinion must request the hospital for a copy of their medical information on a DVD or CD in order to store their own medical data themselves. However, with the launch of this service, patients can manage and view the same images that a doctor uses upon an examination. From December 8, 2017, this service will begin operation at Tosenkai Keiju Medical Center (Ishikawa Prefecture) and will gradually be expanded to other locations. Medical Data Vision and TechMatrix plan to continue to develop and launch services in the imaging field in stages.

The company expects that the impact of this business alliance on FY03/18 full-year results will not be significant.

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
